# MURAL PROPOSAL

---

- Staff will remove the sea creature shaped plaques and damaged scrollwork (lettering would remain).
- Staff will clean and pressure wash the surface.
- Artist will complete the work in sections and affix sea creatures back onto the wall.
- Upon completion, artist will also create a small activity book for children.

# STAFF CONSIDERATIONS

- Upon review, Facilities Maintenance indicated that some of the sea creature plaques may be damaged when removed from wall.
- In the future, should maintenance be needed, the artist is available for repair or touchup at \$15/hour.
- Per Punta Gorda Mural Society, mural lifespan can depend on the quality/status of the building itself; but periodic maintenance is anticipated for all projects.
  - Majority of their murals get repainted after ten years due to fading.
  - Others can go 20+ years with only a periodic resealing.
  - Staff will plan for periodic maintenance in applicable future budget cycle.
