Obstacles

- CEDAB continued to have challenges with reaching quorum
 - 6 meetings were cancelled in Fiscal Year 2021.
 - Updated the meeting time for the Board to retain some members.





- Economic Development Market Feasibility Study
 - Infrastructure focus
 - Influence city-wide
 - Return on investment shown
 - Pro-active in engaging businesses
 - Improved business climate
 - Funding set aside for infrastructure and grant funding

- Completed the Business Tax Equity Study recommending no changes to North Port's fee structure.
 - North Port City Commission decided to not make any changes based on this recommendation.
- Recommendation to Commission to support Suncoast Technical College's funding needs in Tallahassee.
 - Letter was signed and sent by North Port City Commission to our delegation at the State level.
- Completed Annual Sunshine Law Training with Assistant Attorney Golen.



- Started focus on broadband access and initiatives
 - Support the dig-once policy and ensuring citizens and businesses have access to reliable and affordable broadband.
- Conversations with Suncoast Technical College throughout the year on program needs of the community and future build-out plans for their North Port campus
