3		TO THE ART ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS;

7	WHER	REAS, on June 14, 2010, the North Port City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 2014-10 establishing
8	the Ar	t Advisory Board and specifying membership, meetings, and powers and duties, which ordinance is
9	codifie	ed in Chapter 4, Article III of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida; and

11	WHER	REAS, on November 22, 2022, the City Commission repealed and replaced Chapter 59, Public Art, of
12	the Ui	nified Land Development Code pursuant to Ordinance No. 2022-27; and
13		
14	WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that clarification of the membership, meetings, and powers and	
15	duties as provided in Sec. 4-123(b)(8) is necessary for efficient and effective board function; and	
16		
17	WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that these amendments serve the public health, safety, and welfare	
18	of the	citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

20	NOW,	THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

82 (c) The art advisory board shall perform other duties as directed by the city commission related 83 to acquiring, commissioning, installing, placing, maintaining, preserving, protecting, 84 decommissioning, removing, and replacing public art in public places and raising public 85 awareness of art." 86 87 **SECTION 3 - CONFLICTS** 88 89 3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance, in 90 whole or in part, the provisions of this ordinance will prevail to the extent of the conflict. 91 92 **SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY** 93 94 4.01 If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, 95 or provision of this ordinance is for any reason invalid or unconstitutional, that provision will be 96 deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and will not affect the validity of the 97 remaining portions of the ordinance. 98 99 **SECTION 5 – CODIFICATION** 100 101 In this ordinance, additions are shown as underlined and deletions as strikethrough.
