RESOLUTION NO. 2023-R-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE NON-DISTRICT BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 FOR COSTS RELATED TO HURRICANE IAN AND VEHICLE AND DRONE REQUESTS FROM THE POLICE DEPARTMENT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$3,560,528; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2022-R-53 approved the Non-District Budget and Capital Improvement Budget for fiscal year 2022-2023; and

WHEREAS, Florida Statutes Section 166.241(7)(c) requires that a budget amendment be adopted in the same manner as the original budget; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to amend the Non-District Budget for supplemental appropriations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1 – FINDINGS

1.01 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated in this resolution by reference.

SECTION 2 – ADOPTION

2.01 The Non-District Budget for fiscal year 2022-2023 is amended and appropriated as follows:

SECTION 5 – SEVERABILITY

5.01 If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this resolution is for any reason invalid or unconstitutional, that provision will be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the resolution.

SECTION 6 – EFFECTIVE DATE

6.01 This resolution takes effect immediately.
