RESOLUTION NO. 2016-R-17

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO TEMPORARILY SUSPEND ENFORCEMENT OF THE UNIFIED LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE PARKING AND STORAGE OF CERTAIN VEHICLES SECTIONS 25-19(F), (H) AND (J) AS THEY PERTAIN TO BOATS ON LICENSED TRAILERS PARKED ON DRIVEWAYS OR SIDE YARDS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, at the June 28, 2016 meeting, the City Commission directed the city attorney to draft a resolution directing the City Manager to temporarily suspend enforcement of the Unified Land Development Code, parking and storage of certain vehicles Section 25-19(F), (H) and (J) as they pertain to boats on licensed trailers parked on driveways or side yards;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Temporary Suspension of Enforcement

The City Commission hereby directs the city manager to temporarily suspend enforcement of the Unified Land Development Code Sections 25-19(f), (h) and (j) only as they pertain to boats on licensed trailers parked on driveways or side yards. Enforcement will continue and not be suspended for any other scenarios; particularly, enforcement will continue for boats on licensed trailers that interfere with the use of any sidewalk or any right-of-way.

The temporary suspension applies any current or pending Notice of Violations issued in the forty-five (45) days prior to adoption of this Resolution.

Section 2: Duration

The direction to the city manager to temporarily suspend enforcement of the specified provisions of the code herein shall remain in effect through July 12, 2017 unless modified, revoked or extended by the City Commission.

Section 3. Severability

If any section, subsection or portion of this Resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

Section 4. Effective Date.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption by the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida.
