Sec. 82-23. Restricted areas.

The city commission of the City of North Port, Florida, is hereby authorized to establish by resolution areas on the waters within this municipality for any purpose deemed necessary for the safety of the public and property wherein vessel speed and operation may be restricted.

Sec. 82-24. Authorization to establish restrictions.

- (a) The city commission of the City of North Port, Florida, is hereby authorized to establish by resolution maximum vessel speeds within designated restricted areas.
- (b) The city commission of the City of North Port, Florida, is hereby authorized to establish by resolution idle speed no wake zones within designated restricted areas.

Sec. 82-25. Posting of restricted areas.

- (a) Upon the establishment of a restricted vessel speed area pursuant to the provisions of this article, the city shall post speed limit signs specifying maximum speeds for vessels operating within designated areas.
- (b) Upon the establishment of an idle speed no wake zone pursuant to the provisions of this article, the city shall post the limits of the area within which idle speed no wake must be maintained.

Sec. 82-26. Compliance with speed and wake restrictions.

- (a) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any vessel at a speed greater than the maximum speed established and posted pursuant to the provisions of this article.
- (b) It shall be unlawful for any person to operate any vessel at a speed greater than idle speed or which produces any wake within an idle speed - no wake zone established and posted pursuant to the provisions of this article.

Sec. 82-30. Enforcement.

The provisions of this article shall be enforced by any law enforcement agency with jurisdiction within the territorial limits of the City of North Port, Florida.
