WHEREAS, bats provide numerous important ecological services that contribute substantially to the economy of the United States by protecting American forests and agriculture from cropdamaging insects and other such pests and by providing the fundamental benefit of pollination; and

**WHEREAS**, recent bat population losses from White Nose Syndrome, habitat loss, and other factors require attention to ensure the sustainability of our food production systems and protect environmental and human health; and

**WHEREAS**, it is critically important to continue federal, state, and city efforts, including developing new public-private partnerships and increasing citizen engagement, to promote the health of bat populations, increase the quality and quantity of bat roosting and foraging habitat, and help restore bat populations to healthy levels.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, we, the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida, do hereby proclaim April 17<sup>th</sup>, 2024, as
