ORDINANCE NO. 2020-42

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, CHAPTER 58 – PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT, ARTICLE III. – IMPACT FEES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Chapter 58, Article III of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida (“City Code”) imposes impact fees for transportation, fire/rescue, law enforcement, general government, parks, and solid waste (“Impact Fees”); and

WHEREAS, City Code Sections 58-100 through 58-109 establish the provisions governing the imposition of all Impact Fees in the City of North Port; and

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2012, the City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 2012-01, establishing impact fee schedules based on the Impact Fee Study prepared by Tindale-Oliver & Associates, Inc. and dated September 13, 2011 (“Study”); and

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2014, the City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 2014-12, which established Impact Fee Schedules for the Transportation Impact Fee District, the Fire Rescue Impact Fee District, the Law Enforcement Impact Fee District, the General Government Impact Fee District, the Parks Impact Fee District, and the Solid Waste Impact Fee District; and

WHEREAS, on February 24, 2014, the City Commission accepted the Study, in which it was determined that the Impact Fee methodology and the rates contained in the Study were still valid based upon the most recent localized data as required by Section 163.31801, Florida Statutes (“Florida Impact Fee Act”); and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2019, the City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 2019-06, which established the current Impact Fee Schedules for the Transportation Impact Fee District, the Fire Rescue Impact Fee District, the Law Enforcement Impact Fee District, the General Government Impact Fee District, the Parks Impact Fee District, and the Solid Waste Impact Fee District; and

WHEREAS, on June 11, 2019, the City Commission again accepted the Study, in which it was determined that the Impact Fee methodology and the rates contained in the Study were still valid based upon the most recent localized data as required by the Florida Impact Fee Act; and

39 **WHEREAS**, all of the capital improvements planned for and included in the Study, which are to be funded
40 by Impact Fees, are directly related to services that the City of North Port is authorized to provide, and
41 are services required by the general policies of the City pursuant to resolution, code, or ordinance; and

43 **WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds that population growth and non-residential development in the City
44 have continued to increase, straining the adequacy of existing sources of funds to provide capital
45 improvements to meet the demands created by new development; and
46

47 **WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds that the Impact Fees adopted by this article, and based on the Study,
48 are not calculated based on – and will not be spent in order to address – the needs of non-growth-related
49 infrastructure or for operations and maintenance; and
50

51 **WHEREAS**, the revised and updated North Port Comprehensive Plan, adopted in December 2008 and
52 amended from time to time, establishes the policy that land development shall not be permitted unless
53 adequate public capital facilities exist or are assured; and
54

55 **WHEREAS**, the North Port Comprehensive Plan establishes the policy that land development shall bear
56 the full cost of the provision of the new or expanded public capital facilities required by such development;
57 and
58

59 **WHEREAS**, the North Port Comprehensive Plan establishes that the imposition of Impact Fees is a
60 preferred method of regulating land development so as to ensure that it bears the full cost of public capital
61 facilities necessary to accommodate development and to promote and protect the public health, safety,
62 and welfare; and
63

64 **WHEREAS**, based upon the Study, the testimony at public hearings, and a review of all of the facts and
65 circumstances, in the reasonable judgment of the City Commission, the Impact Fees hereby established
66 are at levels no greater than necessary to defray the cost of capital improvements directly related to the
67 categories of residential and nonresidential land development listed herein; and
68

69 **WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds that the Impact Fees imposed by these amendments are based on
70 the most recent, localized data as required by law and that the Impact Fee revenues will only be spent for
71 system improvements for which the fee revenues were collected, consistent with the Study; and
72

73 **WHEREAS**, notice has been provided 90 days in advance of imposing new or increased Impact Fees to
74 fund transportation, fire/rescue, law enforcement, general government, parks, and solid waste
75 improvements necessitated by growth and development in the City in compliance with the Florida Impact
76 Fee Act; and
77

78 **WHEREAS**, the City Commission has determined that the proposed amendments and rates serve the
79 public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.
80

81 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:**

157 **SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS**

159 3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance or
160 provisions thereof, the provisions of this ordinance shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

162 **SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY**

164 4.01 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason
165 held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be
166 deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the
167 validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.

171 5.01 In this ordinance, additions are shown as underlined and deletions as ~~strikethrough~~. Any
172 additional codification information and notations appear in *italics*. These editorial notations shall
173 not appear in the codified text.

177 6.01 This ordinance shall take effect immediately after adoption by the City Commission of the City of
178 North Port, Florida.
