



For more than 39 years, SchenkelShultz has been working throughout Florida on Continuing Services Contracts. Through this experience, we have developed a proven management approach for this type of work. The key to our success is the commitment of a team of experienced architects dedicated throughout the duration of the contract. For this contract, our team will be led by Kenneth (Ken) G. Dean, AIA, LEED®AP Partner-in-Charge. Ken, has completed 116 projects under Continuing Service Contracts and will be supported by a team of architects that bring significant expertise in government/municipal work, specifically with Continuing Services Contracts.

This team includes three Project Manager / Project Architect / Construction Administrators to ensure that any project assigned under this contract will have a team of dedicated professionals who will be readily available and ensure the project is completed on time and within budget. This includes Aaron S. Jacobson, AIA and Roberto Gonzalez, AIA, LEED®AP, who have been working with Sarasota County and Sarasota County Schools on a variety of Continuing Services Contracts. And Rob R. Russell, RA, LEED®AP, who has been alongside with Sarasota County on the Fire Stations #09, #23 and the new Fire Administration Services Building. These are skilled technical architects who know how to manage and lead projects, both large and small. Our team also includes Nathalie J. White, Project Designer, and Gennifer E. Hunt, Interior Designer. The depth and diversity of this talented team will ensure that SchenkelShultz has adequate resources to commit to the wide variety of tasks that can fall under this Continuing Contract.

To meet the varied aspects of a Continuing Services project scope, SchenkelShultz has a proven approach that has been utilized on minor projects and includes the following steps:

- 1. Early Definition of the Scope, Budget & Schedule It is important to define these parameters at the very beginning of the project. This step includes an initial building walk through, if applicable, with preliminary sketches to clearly define the critical scope elements that will affect cost and schedule.

Project meeting dates will be established with goals outlined for each meeting, as well as, the identification of which meetings will be essential for the users to attend.

DESIGN REVIEWS AND COORDINATION

To facilitate communication, design reviews including the user, Project Manager, and architect are critical to the project's success and to the schedule of a project. Once the initial user meeting is completed, project meeting dates will be established with goals outlining each meeting. The significant meetings that will require City review (depending on scope) are, for example, the finalization of the floor plans, the agreement on the building systems, and the review of budget options. After each meeting, minutes will be distributed to all parties attending to communicate the decisions being made. As a project moves into the initial design phase, SchenkelShultz will create three dimensional models to help the City better visualize the design concept. For example, when renovating an office space, SchenkelShultz uses 'Sketch Up' software to generate quick, easy to understand perspectives of design ideas that better illustrate to the client and/or end users what the design imagery of the concept and its components could look like.

As the project progresses into the Design Development and Construction Document phases, SchenkelShultz utilizes Revit software. This software provides detailed modeling capabilities that make it an excellent tool to use when it comes to systems coordination and clash detection / resolution.

SchenkelShultz has the capability to convert the Revit model into AutoCAD as the electronic tool for producing record documents from the contractors' as-builts for the City at the end of construction of the project, if desired.

TECHNOLOGICAL CAPABILITIES

SchenkelShultz's approach to information management systems is to develop regularly scheduled meetings with key stakeholders from the start of the project. While larger projects often require bi-weekly project meetings, Continuing Service projects may require weekly meetings if an accelerated schedule is required. We also use a project tracking spreadsheet in Excel to record all action items resulting from each meeting or discussion. This overall list includes tasks for the entire design team and the client. This is an on-going list that is maintained from project start through completion.

Action items are never removed from this list. Instead, the file is organized with the following information: Item Description, Responsible Individual, Comments, Description of Resolution / Status, and Date Closed.

This ensures that a running record of all decisions is maintained throughout the course of the project and provides The City of North Port with assurance that your input and decisions are incorporated into the final design. In addition to the reporting methods described, SchenkelShultz's plan to manage project information will be further enhanced by various technologybased communication tools, including Web based communication platforms, such as Microsoft Teams. This technology tool enables our team to engage in realtime working collaboration sessions with stakeholder groups, share documents and information remotely, and communicate anywhere, at any time. Our team's ability and experience using these tools extends from the beginning of the project all the way through construction and project closeout.

The ability to successfully manage project records during construction as they relate to costs and administrative services is paramount to a successful project. SchenkelShultz works in record management software. such as Blue Beam, and PlanGrid. These share document submissions, permit requests, RFI responses, and submittals with City staff who will have complete access. This technology greatly enhances our ability to track items, provides immediate answers to status update requests, and streamlines the entire Construction Administration (CA) process.

PERMITTING

The permitting process on a Continuing Services project can include site and water management permits, building only permits, or a combination of both, which will be established in the initial project meeting with the City Project Manager. The permitting dates will be established in the initial schedule created by SchenkelShultz. We will have a preliminary permitting meeting with all parties to eliminate any unusual permitting issues, such as wall ratings, chemical storage and egress requirements. We will actively engage with the Building Division at the City during the permitting phase to ensure that the appropriate agencies are coordinated with.


