Per Resolution 2021-R-09, Section 2.03, City Commission directed the City Manager or designee to distribute a memo to the City Commission identifying all City-submitted grant applications. Staff is preparing a grant application to the Florida Department of Transportation's Safety Concept Paper Grant. The grant will pay traffic safety partners to undertake priority area programs and activities to improve traffic safety and reduce crashes, serious injuries, and fatalities.

The North Port Police Department is requesting two motorcycles and overtime associates with work zone enforcement activities. The cost of the request is expected to be \$100,000. Matching funds are not required.

The grant deadline is February 28, 2022. Notification of award is expected in late fall 2022. If awarded, this would be a reimbursable grant. The City spends first, then submits reimbursement requests to the granting agency for review and payment.
