## **RESOLUTION NO. 2022-R-41**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, ADOPTING CITY COMMISSION POLICY NO. 2022-01 RELATED TO THE INCLUSION OF ITEMS IN THE CITY'S HISTORICAL ARCHIVE; PROVIDING FOR INCORPORATION OF RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission desires to document the history of the municipal government by creating and maintaining an archive of historical items, that will accept, arrange, and preserve historical items donated to or created by the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission intends to have the items maintained in the historical archive available to the public for examination pursuant to Florida's public records law, and for items in the historical archive to be used to promote and encourage research into the history of the municipal government; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds that this policy serves the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

### **SECTION 1 – INCORPORATION OF RECITALS**

1.01 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated in this resolution.

# **SECTION 2 – RESOLUTION**

2.01 The City Commission adopts "Policy No. 2022-01 - Historical Item Archive," attached and incorporated in this resolution, as an administrative policy of the City Commission of the City of North Port.

## **SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS**

3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this resolution and any other resolution, in whole or in part, the provisions of this resolution will prevail to the extent of the conflict.

### **SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY**

4.01 If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this resolution is for any reason invalid or unconstitutional, that provision will be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the resolution.

## **SECTION 5 – EFFECTIVE DATE**

5.01 This resolution takes effect immediately.
