ORDINANCE NO. 2022-23

1 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING WATER AND
2 WASTEWATER CAPACITY FEES; AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT,
3 FLORIDA, SECTION 78-30; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS;
4 PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN
5 EFFECTIVE DATE.

7 WHEREAS, in 2019 a formal analysis of the City’s water and wastewater utility rates, fees, and charges
8 was performed, and the current water and wastewater capacity fees have been in effect since October 1,
9 2019; and
10

11 WHEREAS, the City contracted with GovRates, Inc., to review and analyze the City’s water and wastewater
12 utility rates, fees, charges, and capacity fees; and
13

14 WHEREAS, on July 26, 2022, the City Commission held a properly noticed public meeting to review the
15 analysis, findings, and recommendations of GovRates, Inc., and to receive public comments on adjusting
16 the City’s water and wastewater utility rates, fees, and charges; and
17

18 WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that these amendments serve the public health, safety, and welfare
19 of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.
20

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

23 SECTION 1 - FINDINGS
24

25 1.01 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated in this ordinance by reference.
26

27 SECTION 2 - ADOPTION
28

29 2.01 Chapter 78 of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida is amended as follows:
30

31 “Chapter 78 – UTILITIES
32 . . .

33 ARTICLE II. – WATER AND WASTEWATER UTILITY
34 . . .

35 Sec. 78-30. – Water and wastewater capacity fees.
36

37 (a) *Adoption.* The city hereby adopts and establishes pursuant to general law, a water capacity
 38 fee and a wastewater capacity fee, the purpose of which will be to finance capital
 39 expenditures and the payment of city indebtedness associated with the expansion of the city's
 40 water treatment and transmission system and the wastewater collection, treatment, and
 41 effluent disposal system. The water capacity fee imposed by the city shall be ~~\$1,872.00~~
 42 \$2,319.00 per ERC, and the wastewater capacity fee shall be ~~\$2,213.00~~ \$2,255.00 per ERC.

 44 (d) *Determination of equivalent residential connection factors "ERC" for water and wastewater*
 45 *services.*

46 . . .
 47 (5) For all establishments not listed above:

48
 49 a. The total water equivalent residential connection (ERC) value for water service
 50 capacity shall be determined by multiplying the number of fixture units, as published
 51 in the Standard Plumbing Code, as amended, by ~~30~~ 20, and then dividing that
 52 numerator by 170. For example:

<i>Total Water ERC Value</i>	=	(Number of Fixture Units x 30 <u>20</u>) divided by 170 GPD/ERC

 55 b. The total water equivalent residential connection (ERC) value for wastewater service
 56 capacity shall be determined by multiplying the number of fixture units, as published
 57 in the Standard Plumbing Code, as amended, by ~~30~~ 20, and then dividing that
 58 numerator by 155. For example:

<i>Total Wastewater ERC Value</i>	=	(Number of Fixture Units x 30 <u>20</u>) divided by 155 GPD/ERC

 61 c. The water capacity fees shall be determined by using the following formula:

<i>Total ERC Value x \$1,872.00</i> <u>2,319.00</u>	=	Water Capacity Fee

 64 d. The wastewater capacity fees shall be determined by using the following formula:

<i>Total ERC Value x \$2,213.00</i> <u>2,255.00</u>	=	Wastewater Capacity Fee
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66 . . .
 67 (9) *Effective date.* The effective date of the change in capacity fees shall be on the first day
 68 of the utility billing cycle in ~~October 2019~~ January 2023."

SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS

3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance, in whole or in part, the provisions of this ordinance will prevail to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY

4.01 If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason invalid or unconstitutional, that provision will be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.

SECTION 5 – CODIFICATION

5.01 In this ordinance, additions are shown as underlined and deletions as ~~striketrough~~. Any additional codification information and notations appear in *italics*. These editorial notations are not intended to appear in the codified text.

SECTION 6 – EFFECTIVE DATE

6.01 This ordinance takes effect immediately upon adoption.
