ORDINANCE NO. 02-05

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA CREATING THE SUPPORT SERVICES DEPARTMENT, ESTABLISHING THE FUNCTION OF THE SUPPORT SERVICES DEPARTMENT, AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of North Port retained the services of MGT of America, Inc., in April 2001 to conduct a Management and Organization Study; and

WHEREAS, MGT found the need for combining a number of smaller units that primarily provide services to other City departments; and

WHEREAS, MGT recommends that the Human Resources Department be made a part of the Support Services Department; and

WHEREAS, MGT recommends that the Management Information Services Division, Purchasing Division and Social Services Division be transferred from the Financial Services Department to the Support Services Department; and

WHEREAS, MGT recommends that the Geographic Information Systems Division be transferred from the Community Development Department to the Support Services Department; and

WHEREAS, MGT recommends that the Fleet Maintenance Division be transferred from the Public Works Department to the Support Services Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF NORTH PORT THAT:

SECTION 1. There is created and established the Department of Support Services, which shall consist of the following divisions: Fleet Maintenance, Human Resources, Information Technology, Purchasing and Social Services.

SECTION 2. The City Manager shall appoint the Director of the Support Services Department, who shall report directly to the City Manager. The director shall be appointed for an indefinite term and may be removed at any time pursuant to the City of North Port Personnel Rules and Regulations. The director shall direct the operations of the Support Services Department.



If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon adoption.




