ORDINANCE NO. 2025-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, CALLING FOR A REFERENDUM QUESTION TO BE PLACED BEFORE THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA AT A SPECIAL ELECTION; PROVIDING A REFERENDUM QUESTION DETERMINING WHETHER TO FINANCE A NEW SOLID WASTE TRANSFER STATION THROUGH THE ISSUANCE BY THE CITY OF BONDS PAYABLE FROM THE REVENUES OF THE CITY'S SOLID WASTE DISTRICT; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR THE FILING OF THE ORDINANCE WITH THE SARASOTA COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, it is necessary and desirable and in the best interests of the City to construct a new solid waste transfer station on Silverleaf Road in the east portion of the City, as more particularly described in the plans and specifications on file with the City (the "Solid Waste Transfer Station Project"), in order to promote, improve, maintain, and protect the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City; and

WHEREAS, the most efficient and fair method of financing costs of the Solid Waste Transfer Station Project is through the issuance of bonds (the "Bonds") secured by and payable from the revenues, charges, fees, and assessments derived from the Solid Waste District's operations (the "Solid Waste Revenues"); and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the North Port City Charter, the question as to whether or not such Bonds should be issued to finance costs of the Solid Waste Transfer Station Project must be submitted to the qualified electors of the City at a primary, general, or special election; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission authorizes that a referendum question concerning the issuance of the Bonds for the purpose of financing costs of the Solid Waste Transfer Station Project be submitted to the qualified electors of the City at a special election to be held on May 13, 2025, for consideration by the City's voters; and

WHEREAS, the Sarasota County Supervisor of Elections (the "Supervisor of Elections") advises that in order to obtain placement on the ballot for a May 13, 2025, special election, the Supervisor of Elections has established a deadline of February 17, 2025 for the submission of referendum questions.

NOW	, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:			
	ION 1 – FINDINGS			
1.01	The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated in this ordinance by reference.			
1.02	Pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 166.041(4)(c), a business impact estimate was not required because this ordinance relates to the issuance or refinancing of debt.			
1.03	The City Commission finds that it is necessary and in the best interests of the City to complete the Solid Waste Transfer Station Project in order to promote, maintain, and protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City.			
1.04	The most efficient and fair method of financing a portion of the costs of the Solid Waste Transfer Station Project is through the issuance of the Bonds secured by and payable from Solid Waste Revenues.			
SECT	SECTION 2 – REFERENDUM ELECTION CALLED			
2.01	A referendum election is ordered and called to be held throughout the City of North Port, Florida on May 13, 2025 (the "Referendum Election"). The Referendum Election will be a special election for the purpose of submitting to the City's electors a referendum question as to whether to finance a portion of the costs of the Solid Waste Transfer Station Project through the issuance of bonds in one or more series, secured by and payable from the Solid Waste Revenues. The referendum question is set forth in Section 4 below.			
SECT	ION 3 – CONDUCT OF REFERENDUM ELECTION			
3.01	The Referendum Election called by this ordinance will be conducted in the manner prescribed in Florida Statutes Chapters 100, 101, and 102.			
3.02	The polling places, election officials, and hours of election for the Referendum Election will be as determined by the Supervisor of Elections in accordance with applicable Florida law.			
SECT	ION 4 – FORM OF BALLOT			
4.01	The question pertaining to whether to finance a portion of the Solid Waste Transfer Station Project through the issuance of bonds in one or more series, payable from the Solid Waste Revenues will be submitted to the qualified electors of the City in substantially the following form

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SECII	CTION 9 – CONFLICTS		
9.01	In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance, in whole or in part, the provisions of this ordinance will prevail to the extent of the conflict.		
SECTI	CTION 10 – SEVERABILITY		
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10.01	If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason invalid or unconstitutional, that provision will be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.
