**US41 Multi-Use Trails Maintenance
Agreement
March 27, 2018**

✓ BACKGROUND

- ❑ The City of North Port applied for a grant to design and construct a multi-modal feature on US41 from Sumter Boulevard to Ortiz Boulevard.
- ❑ A project was approved and funded to construct twelve feet wide multi-use trails on both sides of US41 between Tuscola Boulevard and Ortiz Boulevard.
- ❑ These multi-use trails will replace existing sidewalks and construct trails where none currently exist within the project limits.

✓ CURRENT STATUS

- ❑ The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is administering the project.
- ❑ The design is presently at ninety percent completion.
- ❑ The multi-use trails are predominantly on City property, as are the existing sidewalks.
- ❑ This maintenance agreement obligates the City to maintain the multi-use trails and request their replacement when their condition warrants.
- ❑ FDOT requires this agreement before the project advances to bidding the construction of the multi-use trails.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommends City Commission approve Resolution 2018-R-08 authorizing the Mayor to execute the maintenance agreement.
