## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-R-09

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ANNUAL GRANT APPLICATIONS AND RELATED NON-BINDING DOCUMENTS; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, each fiscal year, the City of North Port, Florida routinely applies for multiple grants and authorizes related non-binding documents; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida desires to identify and approve the combined annual grant applications for execution and submission; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida finds that it serves the citizens of the City to direct the City Manager or designee to submit such documents pursuant to this resolution.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:**

### **SECTION 1 – FINDINGS**

1.01 The recitals outlined above are incorporated by reference as findings of fact.

### **SECTION 2 – RESOLUTION**

2.01 The City Commission directs the City Manager or designee to select, execute and submit all relevant grant applications and non-binding documents, including but not limited to, close out documents, certifications, financial documents and reimbursement requests, for the following agencies, when grant funding is available to assist with the budget.

2.02 All binding contracts and contract amendments will continue to require Commission approval.

**SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS**

3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this resolution and any other resolution or portions thereof, the provisions of this resolution shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY**

4.01 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this resolution is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

**SECTION 5 - EFFECTIVE DATE**

5.01 This resolution shall take effect immediately after adoption by the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida.
