Whereas, each citizen of our community is called upon to help protect our source waters from pollution, to practice water conservation, and to get involved in local water issues.


Now, Therefore, We, the City Commission of The City of North Port, Florida do hereby proclaim the week of May 5 – 11, 2019 as:

Drinking Water Week


and encourage each citizen and business to observe this important week by renewing our efforts to conserve water, protect our water sources from pollution and maintain our home water systems in tip-top condition.






