Incident Summary

Gila County Experienced Devastating Flash Flooding in the Cities of Globe, Miami, and unincorporated areas.

Impacted Population:

- Gila County Population: 54,073
 Residences Damaged: 122
- City of Globe Population: 7,230
 Businesses Damaged: 33
- Town of Miami Population: 1,541

Notable Impacts:

- 4 fatalities were confirmed
- Swift, no notice impacts requiring rapid evacuations and alerts
- US 60, the major highway connecting Globe to Phoenix and the route for major resources was impassible
- Over a thousand propane tanks were swept away from a distribution facility causing a serious hazmat incident









Requests for help were made by the City of Globe, Gila County, and the State of Arizona for mutual aid support.

For disaster management, it's essential to bring in help that is both capable and reliable.


