SECTION I:

Bid opening was held on December 4, 2024, one (1) bid was received, the base bid price was as follows:

Responsive and responsible bidder recommendation.

Procurement Analysis Summary

- Watson Civil Construction, Inc. submitted the sole bid, which was found responsive and compliant with solicitation requirements.
- A responsive submittal meets all specifications and addenda, as detailed in the attached bid tabulation.

Vendor Evaluation:

Public Works and Utilities conducted a comprehensive assessment to determine Watson Civil Construction, Inc.'s capability as a responsible bidder. The evaluation confirmed the vendor's:

- Operational capacity
- Organizational integrity
- Reliability
- Technical and financial resources to fulfill contract obligations
- References were checked to ensure the bidder has meet all qualification criteria specified in the solicitation.

City staff met to discuss the solicitation results and determined to reject the bid and negotiate with the lowest, responsive, and responsible vendor to secure the best price for the City within the budgetary guidelines with Watson Civil Construction, Inc.

Pursuant to Chapter 2 Administration, Article VII – Procurement, Sec. 2-404 Per Section 2-411 (f) of City of North Port Procurement Code, it is in the best interest of the City to exercise Reserved Rights as follows: "If fewer than two responsive and responsible bids or proposals are received following any solicitation under this article, the city reserves the right to reject all bids and proposals and to negotiate with any responsible provider to secure the best terms and conditions in the interest of the city".

Please review and analyze the price discrepancy between the consultant's estimate and the higher-priced bid submission.

Specifically, evaluate (cost difference):

- 1. The underlying factors contributing to the variance
- 2. Current market conditions that may have influenced the pricing
- 3. Any assumptions made in the consultant's original estimate
- 4. Components or elements that may have been overlooked in the initial estimate
- 5. Whether recent cost escalations in materials or labor could explain the difference

Please provide your findings and recommendations for addressing this price differential. This may help in estimating future projects.

Following receipt of the bids, the City held several meetings with the contractor to discuss value engineering opportunities, project details, and whether the cost could be negotiated lower. The City and the Contractor were able to reach a reduced contract price through these negotiated meetings. The contractor also recommended a few value engineering opportunities including using imported utility materials and grouting and abandoning in place the existing force main and water main. In addition, the project was bid with various alternatives, each with their own bid price.

Public Works recommends awarding the lowest cost roadway alternative, "Alternate 2" which is for a standard asphalt center turn lane along with the negotiated price and the three value engineering options as described above. The recommended award amount with these options is \$79,283,010.35

Protecting Florida's Investments Act "Scrutinized Companies" Chapter 287.135, Florida Statutes

Chapter 287,135, Florida Statutes was created effective July 1, 2011, and prohibits a company on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in Sudan List or on the Scrutinized Companies with Activities in the Iran Petroleum Energy Sector List from bidding on, submitting a proposal for, or entering into or renewing a contract with an agency or local governmental entity for goods or services of \$1 million or more.

Pursuant to Chapter 215.473, Florida Statutes, the Florida State Board of Administration is charged with maintaining a complete list of scrutinized companies. Scrutinized companies are judged according to whether they meet the following criteria:

- Have a material business relationship with the government of Sudan or a government-created project involving oil related, mineral extraction, or power generation activities, or
 Have a material business relationship involving the supply of military equipment, or
- Impart minimal benefit to disadvantaged citizens that are typically located in the geographic periphery of
- 4. Have been complicit in the genocidal campaign in Darfur.

- Have a material business relationship with the government of Iran or a government-created project involving oil related or mineral extraction activities, or
 Have made material investments with the effect of significantly enhancing Iran's petroleum sector.

The SBA is not responsible for compliance with Chapter 287,135, Florida Statutes, The SBA's responsibilities are solely focused on the Protecting Florida's Investments Act and Chapter 215,473 as it relates to the identification of "Scrutinized Companies" that have prohibited business operations in Sudan or Iran.

The table on the following pages provides the List of Prohibited Investments (Scrutinized Companies). This list is updated as part of the Protecting Florida's Investments Act (PFIA) and the Global Governance Mandates Quarterly Report, upon review and approval by the Trustees of the State Board of Administration.


