RESOLUTION NO. 2020-R-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER OR DESIGNEE TO SIGN AND EXECUTE THE HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM APPLICATION FOR THE REHABILITATION OF WATER CONTROL STRUCTURE 113; INCORPORATING RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of North Port, Florida has the authority to apply for grants; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission directs the City Manager or designee to execute and submit non-binding applications and submissions; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida finds that it serves the citizens of the City to so direct the City Manager or designee to submit an application to the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the Rehabilitation of Water Control Structure 113.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1 – INCORPORATION OF RECITALS

1.01 The recitals outlined above are incorporated by reference as findings of fact as if expressly set forth herein.

SECTION 2 – RESOLUTION

2.01 Upon adoption of this resolution, the City Manager or designee is directed to execute and submit the application and associated documents related to the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program for the Rehabilitation of Water Control Structure 113 including but not limited to: contract, close out documents, certifications, financial documents and reimbursement requests.

2.02 Any contract amendments will require City Commission approval.

SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS

3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this resolution and any other resolution or portions thereof, the provisions of this resolution shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY

4.01 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this resolution is held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 5 - EFFECTIVE DATE

5.01 This resolution shall take effect immediately after adoption by the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida.
