
March 29, 2017 – City Commission Workshop

- **Conceptual design presented by Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc. for Butler Park 50M Competitive Pool with bulkheads, lazy river, support buildings, pool deck for staging and spectator seating, children's pool, and slide feature.**
- **Total Approximate Project Cost 2017 - \$ 9M**

Suggested Design Changes

- Aquatic Center with regional appeal
- Pool Should be multi-generational and more flexible for programming
- Features to include
 - Stretch 25Y Multi-Use Pool (Heated w/ Bulkheads)
 - Lazy River with Zero Depth Beach Entry
 - Children's Play Pool w/ Water Play Structure
 - Water Slides Including Teen Drop or Bowl Slide
 - Support Buildings
 - Lighting, Fencing, Shade
 - Concrete Pool Deck (Staging /Spectator Seating)
 - Spray Features



May 22, 2017 – City Commission Special Meeting



- Revised conceptual design presented by Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc. based on feedback from March 29, 2017 Commission workshop.
- Replaced the 50M competitive pool with a Stretch 25-yard Lap Pool
- Incorporated zero depth entry to lazy river
- Enhanced children's play pool amenities
- Added water slides, bowl slide, spray features, shade and deck seating
- Total Approximate Project Cost 2017 - \$ 12M

Suggested Design Changes

- Separate children's pool from lazy river
- Incorporate wide steps for lesson programming at lazy river
- Add shade to bleachers
- Delete oval canopy at main bathhouse/entry area and made it perpendicular to get more deck space
- Relocate and expand bowl slide
- Add wet deck at river island
- Add artificial turf area inside pool complex for picnicking
- Relocate filtration building



May 25, 2017

- **Conceptual design updated by Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc. based on feedback received at May 22, 2017 Commission special meeting**
- **Separated children's pool from lazy river, incorporated wide steps for lesson programming at lazy river, added shade to bleachers, deleted oval canopy at main entryway, relocated and expanded bowl slide with wet deck at river island**
- **Total Approximate Project Cost 2017 - \$ 12M**
