RESOLUTION NO. 2021-R-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY COMMISSION TO PARTICIPATE IN A JOINT MEETING WITH THE SARASOTA COUNTY COMMISSION TO DISCUSS AND PLAN MATTERS OF MUTUAL INTEREST; INCORPORATING RECITALS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of North Port and the County Commission of Sarasota County desire to hold a joint meeting to discuss and plan matters of mutual interest; and

WHEREAS, a joint meeting may be held at any appropriate public place within the jurisdiction of either participating county or municipality; and

WHEREAS, due public notice must be provided within the jurisdiction of the participating municipalities and counties; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of a resolution authorizing participation in a joint meeting is required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1 – INCORPORATION OF RECITALS

1.01 The recitals outlined above are incorporated by reference as findings of fact as if expressly set forth herein.

SECTION 2 - RESOLUTION

2.01 Pursuant to Section 125.001, Florida Statutes, the City Commission of the City of North Port is authorized to participate in a joint meeting with the County Commission of Sarasota County.

2.02 The joint meeting will take place at the Convocation of Governments on January 15, 2021, at 8:30 a.m. at Suncoast Technical College Conference Center, 4748 Beneva Road, Sarasota, Florida.

2.03 Notice of this joint meeting shall be duly advertised and official minutes shall be taken.

SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS

3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this resolution and any other resolution or portions thereof, the provisions of this resolution shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY

4.01 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phase, or provision of this resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

SECTION 5 – EFFECTIVE DATE

5.01 This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption by the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida.
