**HOPWA CARES ACT FUNDING RE-DESIGNATION AGREEMENT**

**FISCAL YEAR 2019**

The City of North Port elects to re-designate the FY 2019 HOPWA CARES Act funding for the City of North Port - Sarasota - Bradenton, Florida Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) to the State of Florida, Department of Health (FDoH). The FDoH is the designated grantee and recipient of HOPWA CARES Act funds for services benefitting clients within their service area that includes Sarasota County.

The City of North Port hereby relinquishes complete responsibility for grant management activities and administrative oversight for said City of North Port - Sarasota - Bradenton, Florida Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) FY 2019 HOPWA CARES Act funds to the State of Florida immediately. The FDoH also accepts the designation to receive HOPWA CARES Act funds on behalf of the City of North Port - Sarasota - Bradenton, Florida Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) client, effective for FY 2019.

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) acknowledges this re-designation and shall incorporate the HOPWA CARES Act fund allocation for the City of North Port - Sarasota - Bradenton, Florida Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) into the State of Florida Department of Health allocation as one grant for the Federal Fiscal Year 2019.
