ORDINANCE NO. 2025-10

## 1AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA; AMENDING THE CODE OF THE2CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, SECTION 26-3 AND 26-7 RELATING TO FIRE SPRINKLERS3AND EXCEPTIONS TO FIRE SPRINKLERS; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR4CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND5PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- WHEREAS, the Code of the City of North Port, Florida ("City Code"), Chapter 26 Fire Prevention and
  Protection, was adopted and last updated on June 18, 1990, through Ordinance No. 90-13; and

- WHEREAS, City Code Chapter 26 contains the City's fire prevention and protection regulations, providing
   standards for fire prevention, fire suppression, and life safety for the community and environment of the
   City; and
- WHEREAS, On August 6, 2024, the City Commission for the City of North Port, Florida adopted Ordinance
   No. 2024-19 which amended the City Code with new fire safety regulations, in conjunction with the Florida
   Fire Prevention Code, Florida Statutes Chapter 633, National Fire Protection Association and Fire and Life
   Safety Codes; and

- WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to establish exceptions to the fire sprinkler and alarm systems in
   order to improve and minimize the economic burden while not compromising the life safety of emergency
   response personnel and its citizens; and
- WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that these amendments serve the public health, safety, and welfare
   of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

47 48	Exception: Commercial buildings not more than 2,000 gross square feet, without commercial cooking, and an occupant load of less than 10 persons shall be excluded from this

56 57		residential units (apartments, dwelling units, or townhouses) must be designed and			
57		constructed with a commercial fire alarm system that complies with NFPA 70 -National Electrical Code, and NFPA 72National Fire Alarm and Signaling Code.

60		Exception: Commercial buildings not more than 2,000 gross square feet, without commercial			
61	cooking, and an occupant load of less than 10 persons shall be excluded from this
