Whereas, the City of North Port has an award-winning water reuse system and encourages efficient and effective use of reclaimed water


Now, Therefore, We, the City Commission of The City of North Port, Florida do hereby proclaim the week of May 12 – 18, 2019 as:

and encourage each citizen and business to help protect our precious water resources by practicing efficient and effective use of reclaimed water.


