WHEREAS, the Nation and the free world are eternally grateful for the contributions of American Veterans - men and women - to the advancement of the cause of an honorable world peace.


NOW, THEREFORE, we, the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida, do hereby proclaim November 11th, 2021 as:

and ask that the day be observed with appropriate ceremonies in honor of those who have served to preserve the principles of Justice, Freedom and Democracy.






