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7	WHEREAS, on August 6, 2024, the City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 2024-13, repealing the Unified					
8	Land Development Code, Chapters 1, 5, 9, 13, 14, 17, 18, 21, 25, 28, 33, 37, 41, 45, 49, 53, 55, 57, 58, 59					
9	60, and 61, and replacing those chapters with Chapters 1 through 4 and 6, and Appendices; and					
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11	WHEREAS, certain references in Chapter 2 of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida ("City Code") are					
12	no longer accurate, as the Unified Land Development Code ("ULDC") renamed the "Tree Fund" to the					
13	"Environmental Protection Fund" and revised regulations regarding tree removal; and					
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15	WHEREAS, these amendments are required to achieve consistency between the City Code and the ULDC
