(1) No member of the Zoning Board of Appeals shall hold any elective office or be employed by the City. (2) All board appointees shall have resided within the city for a period of one year. Residency must be maintained throughout the term of office. Failure to maintain permanent residency within the city shall result in automatic vacation of the board seat. (3) No person shall be appointed with private or personal interests likely to conflict with the general public interest. (4) To the greatest extent possible, at least three (3) members of the Zoning Board of Appeals shall have experience and expertise in zoning, land use, and related topics.
