

Sec. 5.06. - Advisory boards and committees.

- (a) The City Commission may appoint advisory boards and committees composed of citizens qualified to act in an advisory capacity to the City Commission, the City Manager or to any department of the City government, with respect to the conduct and management of any property or institution or the exercise of any public function of the City. The members of any such board or committee shall serve without compensation and at the pleasure of the City Commission. Their duties shall be to consult and advise with appropriate municipal officers and make written recommendations which shall become part of the records of the City.
- (b) The City Commission shall always maintain the following Advisory Boards:
 - 1. Charter Review Advisory Board
 - 2. Planning and Zoning Advisory Board
