ORDINANCE NO. 2024-26

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE VILLAGE E VILLAGE DISTRICT PATTERN PLAN (WEST VILLAGES AKA WELLEN PARK); AMENDING THE UNIFIED LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE TO REFERENCE THE AMENDED VILLAGE DISTRICT PATTERN PLAN; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

- 1 WHEREAS, the City of North Port, Florida is committed to planning and managing the future growth and
- development of the City by adhering to its Comprehensive Plan and Unified Land Development Code

WHEREAS, on July 23, 2019, the City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 2019-25, establishing the Village
 E Village District Pattern Plan; and

WHEREAS, Applicant Jackson R. Boone, Esq., agent on behalf of Sarasota County Public Hospital District ("Applicant"), filed Petition No. VPA-24-078, requesting the amendment of the Village E Village District Pattern Plan; and

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2024, Applicant held noticed neighborhood meeting(s) related to this pattern plan;
 and

- WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Advisory Board considered the Petition at a public hearing on
 July 11, 2024 and made its recommendation to the City Commission; and
- 16 WHEREAS, the City Commission held properly-noticed public hearings at first and second reading of this
- ordinance, at which time all interested parties had an opportunity to appear and be heard, and the City
- 18 Commission considered all relevant evidence presented, as well as the Planning and Zoning Advisory
- 19 Board's recommendation; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that competent substantial evidence supports the findings and
- 21 actions herein; and
- 22 WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that its action serves the public health, safety, and welfare of the
- 23 citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

NOW,	THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:
SECTION	ON 1 – FINDINGS
1.01	The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated in this ordinance by reference.
1.02	Pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 166.041(4)(c), a business impact estimate was not required because this ordinance is enacted to implement Part II of Florida Statutes Chapter 163, relating to growth policy, county and municipal planning, and land development regulation, including zoning, development orders, development agreements, and development permits.
.03	The City Commission finds the regulations in this ordinance to be consistent with the North Port Comprehensive Plan.
04	The City Commission makes the following additional findings:
	a. This amended Village District Pattern Plan is consistent with the ULDC, including Chapter 53, which provides the minimum requirements of the Village zoning district.
	b. This amended Village District Pattern Plan meets all requirements of ULDC Section 53-214, which provides the minimum requirements of a Village District Pattern Plan.
	c. This amended Village District Pattern Plan is consistent with the West Villages Village District Pattern Book and the West Villages Index Map.
05	The City Commission finds that, pursuant to Section 14 of Chapter 2023-304, Laws of Florida, this amendment to the land development regulations is not more restrictive or burdensome than current regulations.
1.06	This amendment is made pursuant to VPA-24-078, filed by applicant Jackson R. Boone, Esq. Agent on behalf of Sarasota County Public Hospital District. The associated application was initiated by a private party, other than the City of North Port, Florida. The property that is the subject of the application is owned by the initiating private party.
1.07	All identified exhibits are incorporated in this ordinance by reference.
