4. Project/Program Description

The City of North Port has committed over \$13.8 million to build a new, state of the art Emergency Operations Center (EOC). The requested funds will be used to provide the furnishings, fixtures, and equipment (FFE) necessary to fully outfit the EOC, the final funding necessary to complete this project. The City of North Port is one of the fastest-growing communities in Florida and faces a range of natural hazards, including flooding, hurricanes, and wildfires. A fully functional EOC is essential to coordinating emergency preparedness, response, recovery, and mitigation operations that protect lives and property.

13. **Program Performance**

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?

Outfitting the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) with furnishings, fixtures, and equipment will ensure the facility is fully functional, resilient, and capable of supporting coordinated emergency management operations. The goal is to create an environment that enables efficient communication, decision-making, and resource coordination during disaster response and recovery activities. This will enhance operational readiness, improve situational awareness and coordination, and support continuity of operations for the City of North Port.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Outfitting the EOC with furniture, fixtures, and equipment will support a fully staffed emergency response during times of disaster. Having current equipment for use during emergencies is imperative in continuity of operations. Community outreach and education will be provided during blue skies, as well as collaboration with internal and external partners including North Port's Community Emergency Response Teams (CERTs).

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

The Situation Room, Emergency Call Center, Joint Information Center, and Backup Data Center will be located in this building. During times of emergency, citizens will receive emergency management and support services. During non-emergency times, Emergency Management will provide community outreach and preparedness services available to the citizens.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

This project does not have a specific target population as all citizens would benefit. Current population estimated to be served is 94,600.

- e. What is the expected benefit or outcome of this project? What is the methodology by which this outcome will be measured?
- 1. Benefit: Faster response times due to coordinated resource deployment. Measure: reduced response times.
- 2. Benefit: Resource prioritization for most critical need. Measure: reduced request and resolution times.
- 3. Benefit: Continuity of operations for essential government and critical infrastructure during times of crisis. Measure: reduced resolution times for restoration of essential services.
