| McKibben Park | 5500 Trekeil St. | N/A | Approve use of up to 2 spaces | Good location to expand offerings. Park has paved parking and a restroom. As per other locations, operation must be within park operating hours, respectful of neighbors. |
| Atwater Park | 4475 Skyway Ave. | N/A | Approve near Splashpad, not during Little League games | Little League concessions are a large portion of league's fundraising. Food truck operations should be designed to minimize impact. |
| Canine Club | 6700 Appomattox Dr. | N/A | Do not approve at this time. | Food is prohibited to be brought in the park. Parking is very limited. Patrons cannot leave dogs unattended in park while visiting the food truck. Food should not be brought into gated section of the park. |
| LaBrea | 6340 LaBrea St. | N/A | Approve use of up to 2 spaces | This park has paved parking and other amenities, however is surrounded by houses and lacking a restroom. |
| Butler Park | 6203 W. Price Blvd. | N/A | Do not approve at this time. | Options for concessions already exist at this location and it appears that the need is currently met. Food trucks would compete with the leagues and the NPAC concessions. |
| Hope Park | 8161 Lombra Ave. | N/A | Do not approve at this time. | This is a pocket park surrounded by houses. The park does not have paved parking or a restroom. |
| Kirk Park | 8305 Trionfo Ave. | N/A | Do not approve at this time. | This is a pocket park surrounded by houses. The park does not have paved parking or a restroom. |
| Marina Park | 7030 Chancellor Blvd. | N/A | Do not approve at this time. | Very Minimal parking, not a park where patrons gather, and it is surrounded by houses. |
| Marius Park | 6890 Marius Rd. | N/A | Do not approve at this time. | This is a pocket park surrounded by houses. The park does not have paved parking or a restroom. |
| Myakkahatchee Creek Environmental Park | 6968 Reisterstown Rd. | N/A | Do not approve at this time. | Natural area; maintain conservation parks without commercialism. |
| Narramore Sports Complex | 7508 Glenallen Blvd. | N/A | Do not approve at this time. | Leagues operate two concessions within this complex at varying times. Food trucks would impact leagues' fundraising abilities. Very limited parking. |
| North Port Skate Park | 5651 North Port Blvd. | N/A | Do not approve at this time. | No adjacent parking for a food truck, park is served by food trucks at Dallas White Park. |
| Oaks Park | 5430 Mandrake Terr. | N/A | Do not approve at this time. | Natural area; maintain conservation parks without commercialism. |
| Pine Park | 4556 McKibben Dr. | N/A | Do not approve at this time. | This is a pocket park surrounded by houses. The park has very minimal paved parking and does not have a restroom. Could be served by food trucks down the street at McKibben. |
| Veterans Park | 13750 South Tamiami Trl. | N/A | Do not approve at this time. | Very minimal parking, shared with the library. |
| Warm Mineral Springs Park | 12200 San Servando Ave. | N/A | Do not approve at this time. | Contractor does not permit food to be brought into the Springs, contractor has right to provide food upon City approval. |
