
Proposal for Annual North Port Environmental Health Town Hall

Background

According to the City's Environmental Resiliency & Sustainability Pillar of the Strategic Vision Plan: "North Port seeks to be the role model in the region as a community that values environmental sustainability in the design and operation of its facilities, programs, services, and development through forward-thinking policies, ordinances, and education."

An example of executing on this vision is the city, on the recommendation of the Environmental Advisory Board, recently began publishing an Environmental Scorecard (ES) as a way to start objectively measuring our city's environmental health. North Port's ES is a first of its kind, not only in Florida, but nationwide.

We now have the opportunity to enhance this leadership position and expand engagement by hosting an Annual North Port Environmental Health Town Hall.

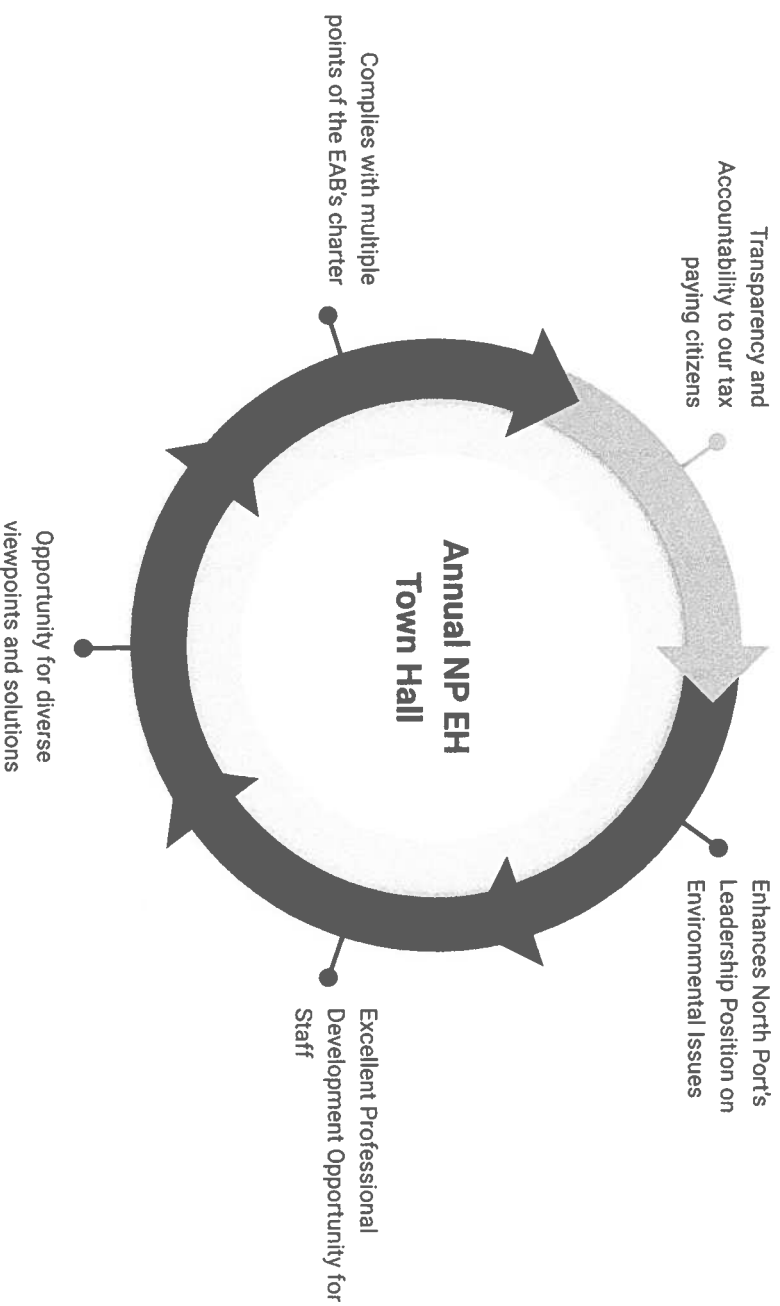
Annual North Port Environmental Health Town Hall
