

**Reference: RFB No. 2020-21 Bridge Water Main Replacement – N. Salford Boulevard
Letter of Recommendation**

The City of North Port Purchasing department received bid submittals for this project from three bidders. Purchasing reviewed the bid submittals and determined the bidders to be responsive. The apparent low bidder is Spectrum Underground with a total bid price of \$118,967.00.

To demonstrate their qualifications, bidders were required to submit a minimum of three recent (completed within the past five years) project references of similar size and scope. Spectrum Underground provided four references in their bid submittal package. The reference projects are described below:

1. Canal Road 12-inch Water Main Replacement (Manatee County): Spectrum Underground installed approximately 7,000 linear feet of a 12-inch replacement water main along Canal Road in Manatee County. The work included two horizontal directional drills totaling approximately 930 linear feet. The water main installed by horizontal directional drill passes under stormwater facilities. There were five connections to existing water mains along the project route. The contact at Manatee County for this project is Michael Sturm, P.E.
2. Oak Ford Pump Station Force Main (Sarasota County): Spectrum Underground upgraded an existing lift station and constructed a new lift station along with approximately 47,000 linear feet of 4-inch, 6-inch and 8-inch force mains. The new force mains were installed using open cut and horizontal directional drill methods. The project was part of the decommissioning of the Oak Ford WWTP. The client was the Sarasota County and the CEI contact was Cory Best with Stantec.
3. Stantec was unable to contact anyone at City of Sarasota that was familiar with Spectrum Underground's referenced project.
4. McIntosh Middle School Water Main and Force Main Installation (Sarasota County): Spectrum Underground was the contractor on this project. The utility mains installed by Spectrum Underground were mainly installed using horizontal directional drill methods, the drilling was performed by a sub-consultant. The contact at Sarasota County for this project was Jason Brown.

Three of the four references provided in Spectrum Underground's bid submittal package responded to Stantec's request to provide feedback. The reference contacts we spoke with were able to confirm the reference projects were finished on schedule. No issues with excessive change orders or change requests were reported. The contacts stated that they experienced no issues with complaints from the public. The contacts described their working relationships and experiences with Spectrum Underground as positive and stated that they would work with them again in the future on similar projects.

Stantec has checked the Florida Department of Business and Professional Regulation database, the contractor holds license as a Certified General Contractor and a Certified Utility and Excavation Contractor. No complaints are shown to be on file against their licenses. These licenses expire on August 31, 2020.

We received no feedback from the responsive project reference contacts for Spectrum Underground that indicated that the contractor would not be capable of completing the work in a manner that would be satisfactory to the City of North Port.
