**ORDER TERMINATING EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 2020-08 RELATING TO TEMPORARY
PROCUREMENT PROCESSES AND THE CONDUCT OF PUBLIC PROCUREMENT MEETINGS
BY COMMUNICATIONS MEDIA TECHNOLOGY**

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2020, the City Manager issued Emergency Order No. 2020-08 relating to temporary procurement processes and the conduct of public procurement meetings by communications media technology; and

WHEREAS, on May 12, 2020, the City Commission ratified Emergency Order No. 2020-08; and

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2020, Florida Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order Number 20-112, declaring Phase One of reopening the state; and

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2020, the City implemented Phase One of returning employees to work; and

WHEREAS, on June 1, 2020, the City will enter Phase Two of returning employee to work sites; and

WHEREAS, this return to work negates the conditions that necessitated the regulations in Emergency Order No. 2020-08.

IN HIS EMERGENCY AUTHORITY, THE CITY MANAGER OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA ORDERS:

Emergency Order No. 2020-08 is hereby terminated.

This order is effective immediately.
