Good morning,

After consultation with the Civil Division of the Us Attorney's office for the District of Columbia, the public release of the MOU is prohibited due to the designation of "Law Enforcement Sensitive" because in the aggregate, if all of them were to be made public, then it would be clear how many law enforcement agencies would be providing support at the Inauguration.

The Department of Justice and law enforcement agencies never release the numbers of law enforcement agents involved in any event as this would allow persons bent on criminal activity to know the security force utilized and the numbers of law enforcement would need to be overcome to further any criminal activity.

Therefore, you should not look at your MOU in isolation, but as a whole with regard to the 2017 Presidential Inaugural Task Force .
