Commissioners,

A question was asked by a Commissioner regarding the upcoming agenda item for the 4/26 Commission meeting:

Question: Could you please confirm the correct paperwork was uploaded for 2<sup>nd</sup> reading? The Leg Text states "added for 2<sup>nd</sup> reading," but those changes were not included in the 2<sup>nd</sup> reading documents for both Villages.

Answer: At the first reading, the motion was made to continue to April 26, taking the conversation and the scrivener's errors into consideration. Due to the agenda deadline being so short, the changes could not be made before the April 26 second reading, so the legislative text is not updated. However, provided the City Commission motions to approve subject to incorporation of the changes per the discussion at first reading, the applicant would be required to provide an updated version before codification.
