ORDINANCE NO. 2024-36

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE NON-DISTRICT BUDGET AND CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 FOR HURRICANE IAN REPAIRS AND ENVIRONMENTAL PARK REPAIRS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,350,302; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR POSTING; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 2023-R-59 approved the Non-District Budget and Capital Improvement Budget for fiscal year 2023-2024; and

WHEREAS, North Port City Charter Section 7.03 provides that a general appropriation ordinance shall be enacted to reflect the daily operation of the City for each ensuing fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City intends going forward to adopt and amend its non-district budgets and capital improvement budgets by ordinance, pursuant to City Charter Section 7.03; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 2024-35 ratified, validated, and confirmed all resolutions that adopted or amended the City's Non-District and Capital Improvement Budgets, including Resolution No. 2023-R-59; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission desires to amend the Non-District Budget and Capital Improvement Budget for supplemental appropriations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1 – FINDINGS

- 1.01 The above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated in this ordinance by reference.
- 1.02 Pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 166.041(4)(c), a business impact estimate was not required because this ordinance relates to the adoption of budgets or budget amendments, including revenue sources necessary to fund the budget.

SECTION 2 – ADOPTION

2.01 The Non-District Budget and Capital Improvement Budget for fiscal year 2023-2024 is amended and appropriated as follows:

SECTION 3 – POSTING OF BUDGET AMENDMENT

3.01 Within five days of the effective date of this ordinance, the City Manager is directed to post the budget amendment on the City's website. Pursuant to Florida Statutes Section 166.241(9), the budget amendment must remain on the website for at least two years.

SECTION 4 – CONFLICTS

4.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance, in whole or in part, the provisions of this ordinance will prevail to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 5 – SEVERABILITY

5.01 If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason invalid or unconstitutional, that provision will be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.

SECTION 6 – EFFECTIVE DATE

6.01 This ordinance takes effect immediately upon adoption.
