## RESOLUTION NO. 2021-R-03

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, ADOPTING CITY COMMISSION POLICY NO. 2021-02 RELATED TO CITY COMMISSIONER SUPPLIES, INCLUDING OFFICE SUPPLIES, BUSINESS CARDS, NAME BADGES, AND CLOTHING; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 2-24(b) of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida (the "City Code") regulates what supplies the City furnishes to City Commissioners; and

**WHEREAS**, this policy supersedes and takes the place of those policies codified at Section 2-24(b) of the City Code, which have been repealed on this date by Ordinance No. 2020-43; and

**WHEREAS**, it is the intent of the City Commission to establish a policy to address certain expenses of the City Commission and to ensure consistency in the purchasing of supplies and other expenses of the City Commission; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds that this policy serves the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:**

### **SECTION 1 – INCORPORATION OF RECITALS**

1.01 The recitals outlined above are incorporated by reference as findings of fact as if expressly set forth herein.

### **SECTION 2 – RESOLUTION**

2.01 The City Commission hereby adopts Policy No. 2021-02 "City Commission Supplies," which is attached hereto and incorporated as if set forth herein, as an administrative policy of the City Commission of the City of North Port.

### **SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS**

3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this resolution and any other resolution or portions thereof, the provisions of this resolution shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY**

4.01 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phase, or provision of this resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.

**SECTION 5 – EFFECTIVE DATE**

5.01 This resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption by the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida.
