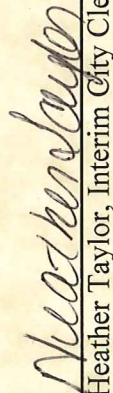
Now, Therefore, WE, the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida, do hereby proclaim November 16, 2019, as

and commend and offer heartfelt gratitude to all Ukrainian American Veterans for serving their Country, The United State of America, with integrity and valor.

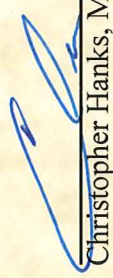

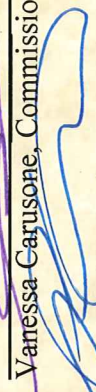

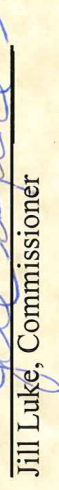
