

# SUMTER/PRICE

## PUBLIC ART SCULPTURE PROJECT



- At the March 2, 2021 City Commission Regular Meeting consensus was given to direct the Art Advisory Board to provide options for a sturdy, low maintenance, and more visible art structure to replace the Roseate Spoonbill Sculpture that was previously located in front of Walgreen's on the corner of Price and Sumter Boulevard.
- At the October 12, 2021 Art Advisory Board meeting, the members voted unanimously to submit the Future Fish proposal by St. Pete artist Donald Gialanella for City Commission consideration and approval.

# Estimated Project Budget\*

# Additional Considerations

- Potential UV degradation, surface scratching, and/or breakage of plexiglass material.
- Existing lighting may need to be enhanced post installation.
