ORDINANCE NO. 2024-23

- AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, RELATING TO THE NORTH PORT 1 ROAD AND DRAINAGE DISTRICT AND THE CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC ROAD FEE; 2 3 AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, CHAPTER 66, SPECIAL 4 DISTRICTS, ARTICLE III. - ROAD AND DRAINAGE DISTRICT, TO ELIMINATE CONFLICTS 5 WITH THE UNIFIED LAND DEVELOPMENT CODE, UPDATE REFERENCES, CLARIFY 6 ENFORCEMENT PROVISIONS, AND CLARIFY THE TIMING OF PAYMENT FOR THE 7 CONSTRUCTION TRAFFIC ROAD FEE; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR 8 CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND 9 **PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**
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WHEREAS, on August 6, 2024, the City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 2024-13, providing for the
repeal of Unified Land Development Code ("ULDC"), Chapters 1, 5, 9, 13, 14, 17, 18, 21, 25, 28, 33, 37, 41,
45, 49, 53, 55, 57, 58, 59, 60, and 61, and replacement of those chapters with Chapters 1 through 4 and
6, and Appendices; and

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- WHEREAS, on August 6, 2024, the City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 2024-14 providing for the
 repeal of Unified Land Development Code, Chapter 29, and replacement of that chapter with Chapter 5;
 and
- WHEREAS, provisions in Chapter 66, Article III of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida ("City Code")
 regarding review of construction and paving plans conflict with the ULDC; and
- 23 **WHEREAS,** provisions in Chapter 66, Article III of the City Code regarding regulation and permitting of 24 signs in the right-of-way conflict with Chapter 5 of the ULDC; and
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- WHEREAS, these amendments are required to achieve consistency between the City Code and the ULDC;and
- WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that these amendments serve the public health, safety, and welfare
 of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

74		(a) Pursuant to authority of this Article, the District has the power to require permits for the				
75		placement of structures , signs and other fixtures within the Road and Drainage right-of-way				
76		of the City of North Port.

78		(b) The governing body shall, by resolution, adopt procedures for the issuance of permits for the				
79		placement of structures , signs and other fixtures within the Road and Drainage right-of-way				
80		of the City of North Port.				
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82	(c) Except as otherwise provided in this section, no person shall construct, install, place or
83	maintain structures , signs or other fixtures within the Road and Drainage right-of-way of the
84	City of North Port without a currently valid permit issued by the District.
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86	(d) Right-of-way use permits shall not be required for the temporary placement of garage sale
87	signs.

89	(e) Right of way use permits shall not be required for the temporary placement of real estate
90	"Open House" signs provided that such temporary placement is in compliance with the
91	following terms and conditions:
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93	(1) No more than three directional signs may be placed within the City right-of-way per "open
94	house".
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96	(2) Directional signs shall not exceed two square feet in size.
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98	(3) The name, address and telephone number of the person placing the "Open House" sign
99	within the City right of way and the date of the open house shall be written on each sign.
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101	(4) No more than three "Open House" signs may be placed within the City right-of-way
102	adjacent to the real property for sale. Such signs shall not exceed four square feet in size.
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104	(5) "Open House" signs may be placed within the City right-of-way from dawn to dusk on the
105	day the open house is to be conducted.
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107	(6) All "Open House" signs must be removed from the City right-of-way by dusk on the day(s)
108	the open house is conducted.
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110	(7) No "Open House" sign may be nailed, fastened or affixed to any tree, utility pole, street
111	sign or any traffic control device.
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113	(f <u>d</u>) The construction, installation, placement or maintenance of structures , signs or other fixtures
114	within the Road and Drainage right-of-way of the City of North Port, without a currently valid
115	permit issued by the District or in violation of the terms and conditions of this Section shall
116	constitute a violation of this Article.

118	(ge) Any structure, sign or other fixture constructed, installed, placed or maintained within the
119	Road and Drainage right-of-way of the City of North Port, without a currently valid permit
120	issued by the District or in violation of the terms and conditions of this Section, shall constitute
121	a public nuisance and may be removed by the District as provided by law.
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123	(h) All "Open House" signs shall be set back a minimum of 15 feet from the travel lane or, in the
123	absence of a 15-foot right of way area, "Open House" signs shall be set back one half of the
125	distance of the right-of-way area from the travel lane.

132		(a) A construction traffic road fee is hereby established. The fee must be paid prior to the			
133		issuance of a building-right-of-way use permit and will be assessed as follows:			
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136		Sec. 66-70. Enforcement.			
137		(a) In addition to other lawful enforcement procedures, the city may enforce the collection of			
138		charges required by the road maintenance rehabilitation program by withholding delivery of			
139		building <u>a right-of-way use permits until the construction traffic road fees are paid.</u>

141		(b) Construction that has begun without the payment of the construction traffic road fees shall			
142		be handled subject to enforcement pursuant to other sections Chapter 2, Article IX of this			
143		Code and/or the Florida Building Code with regard to construction without a building permit.

147		(a) Timing. Prior to the issuance of a building right-of-way use permit, a property owner or			
148		authorized applicant intending to engage in construction of a multi-family residential,			
149	nonresidential, or commercial development may request a waiver of the applicable				
150	construction traffic road fee by submitting an application for the fee waiver on the city's				
151	approved form. In the event the property owner or authorized applicant seeks issuance of a				
152		building right-of-way use permit before the final determination is made on a pending fee			
153		waiver application, then the total construction traffic road fees due must be deposited with			
154		the city prior to its issuance of the building right-of-way use permit, and a refund shall be			
155		issued by the city if the waiver is granted
