







# North Port's Safety Comparison

- ◆ We as a department believe that North Port has a relatively low crime rate, but does it?
- ◆ In an effort to see where reported crime in North Port stacks up compared to 11 cities with similar service and population totals<sup>1</sup>, the annual Uniformed Crime Reports (UCR) were examined for 2016, 2017, and 2018.

# UCR Part 1 Crimes

- UCR Part I, or Violent Crimes are:
  - Homicide (Murder)
  - Rape
  - Robbery
  - Aggravated Assault (Including Aggravated Stalking)
  - Burglary
  - Theft (Larceny)
  - Motor Vehicle (MV) Theft

# Procedure

- ◇ Created 3-year averages for each of the 11 cities/ Police Department's and crime category.
  - ◇ Calculated a percentage difference and actual difference for each category.
  - ◇ Heat mapped crime averages for a quick visual representation of how North Port compares to the others.
- ◇ Calculated Overall Ranking of Total Crime Index for each of the 11 Cities.






