## City of North Port

*NOW, THEREFORE, WE*, the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida, do hereby proclaim Monday, November 11, 2019, as:



and ask that the day be observed with appropriate ceremonies in honor of those who have served to preserve the principles of Justice, Freedom and Democracy.






