Whereas, on behalf of the entire City Commission, we want to express our sincere appreciation to Richard Lockhart for his loyalty to the City of North Port.


Now, Therefore, we the City Commission of the City of North Port, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, April 9, 2019 as:







