#### **REQUEST FOR LETTERS OF INTEREST 2023-11**

### CITY OF NORTH PORT WARM MINERAL SPRINGS GEOTECHNICAL INVESTIGATION/SURVEY

The City of North Port is currently accepting letters of interest from firms for Professional Engineering Services for NPU, Category 5.

**INTENT:** It is the intention of the City to secure the professional services of a qualified firm to perform geotechnical investigations and surveys to determine the ability of the site to support development without compromising the existing underground features. The areas of concentration of the investigations and surveys should be as shown on the attached Warm Mineral Springs Enclave Conceptual Site Plan.

#### **BACKGROUND/SCOPE OF SERVICES:**

#### **BACKGROUND**

The City of North Port (City) owns and operates Warm Mineral Springs. This approximately 81-acre park features the only warm spring in Florida, with a consistent average temperature of 85 degrees year-round. The spring water is rumored to have one of the highest mineral contents of any natural spring in the United States and is internationally known for its purported healing qualities. Evidence of prehistoric man, saber-toothed tigers, and giant sloths have been discovered at Warm Mineral Spring Park, dating back more than 10,000 years. The spring is listed on the U.S. National Register of Historic Places.

Recognizing citizen and visitor support for continued access to Warm Mineral Spring and a dire need to rehabilitate the facility, the City released an RFP in September 2017 to develop a Master Plan for the entire 81-acre Park, including restoration of the historic buildings. Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc. was awarded Contract #2017-40 for development of the Master Plan, which includes provisions noting that Kimley-Horn & Associates, Inc. is to be utilized for all design and engineering phases related to implementation of the Master Plan.

There is also a desire to create a sense of place within the 60 acres +/-, of currently undeveloped natural area that increases quality of life for the community.

The City of North Port received an unsolicited detailed proposal recognized by City Commission as a qualifying project under Florida Statutes Section 255.065(1)(L) from Warm Mineral Springs Development Group LLC's. In response, the

City issued a Request for Proposals for a comprehensive agreement in the form of a Public-Private Partnership (P3)—harmonious with those amenities contained in a previously-developed Master Plan—for a portion of Warm Mineral Springs (WMS) Park, located at 12200 San Servando Ave., North Port, FL 34287, Parcel 0769070014 that builds upon an already present tourist market, provides additional tourism and health focused amenities, and enhances the City's economic development goals for the area.

#### **SCOPE OF SERVICES**

#### TASK 1- PROJECT MANAGEMENT AND COORDINATION

This task will include overall project management by the consultant and coordination with the City and attendance at project meetings. This task will include a project kickoff meeting with City staff to review the project, regulatory concerns, effects related to Chapter 267 Florida Historical Resources Act (F.S.) and any items pertinent to the progress of the project including any known archaeological impacts

Additional data may be requested as needed. The firm will work with City staff to acquire the information. This may include phone calls, meetings, site visits and email communications with staff.

#### TASK 2 – DESIGN OF INVESTIGATION PLAN/SURVEY

The firm will prepare a plan of investigation and surveys and present it to the City for approval prior to doing any field work. In consideration with the reports from previous studies and evaluations, attached, the plan will include a detailed list of studies necessary to map the underground feeder veins of the spring, rock strata, hydrostatic pressure, and similar qualities of the areas surrounding the springs including a specific Sink Hole Evaluation and Investigation to provide data to guide the consideration of development around the Warm Mineral Spring site.

#### TASK 3 – REPORT OF FINDINGS

The firm shall provide an electronic copy, and one original hard copy of their plan of investigation by four (4) weeks after the Kickoff meeting. The fieldwork associated with the approved plans will be complete by ten (10) weeks after the City's approval. A draft report of the fieldwork findings will be prepared and submitted to the City fourteen (14) weeks after the approved plans. The City will review within two (2) weeks and provide any comments. The final report of findings will be submitted to the City within two (2) weeks of the City's review. Plans, reports and all other written material will be provided electronically in Microsoft Word format and portable document format (pdf). Any plans will be provided in (pdf) and in AutoCAD. Once this contract is complete, all plans, reports and other details will become property of City.

#### **DELIVERABLES**

The deliverables to be provided for this project include the following:

- Kick-off meeting minutes
- Data request
- Detailed plan for investigation
- Draft report of findings
- Final report of findings

#### PROPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

Engineers are to provide references for at least three (3) similar projects within the last 10 years. Name, email and phone numbers are required for appropriate contact for each reference.

Proposals shall specify the project team to include the project manager, task manager, and field staff, detailing each team member's specific experience as it relates to this project.

Proposals are to include the names of all subcontractors to be used on this project.
