



# City of North Port

## ORDINANCE NO. 2021-27

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, AMENDING THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, SECTION 4-123 TO MODIFY THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE ART ADVISORY BOARD; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission desires to expand the powers and duties of the Art Advisory Board; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission finds that the proposed amendments serve the public health, safety, and welfare of the citizen of the City of North Port, Florida.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:**

### **SECTION 1 – FINDINGS**

1.01 The recitals outlined above are ratified and approved as true and correct, and are incorporated by reference as findings of fact.

### **SECTION 2 – ADOPTION**

2.01 Chapter 4 of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida is hereby amended as follows:

**“Chapter 4 – BOARDS AND COMMITTEES**

...

**ARTICLE III. – ART ADVISORY BOARD**

...

**Sec. 4-123. – Powers and duties.**

(a) The art advisory board shall serve as an information resource to and advise the city commission on acquisitions, commissions, installation, placement, maintenance, preservation, protection, decommissions, removal, and replacement of art in public places in the city.

(b) (a) The art advisory board shall advise and recommend on the following matters:

- (1) Advise the city commission on the installation and rotation of art exhibits ~~The rotation of an art exhibit~~ within city hall and the police department, and install and rotate the exhibits.
- (2) Advise the city commission ~~Recommendations~~ on the acquisition or donation, selection, installation, and placement of artwork in ~~within~~ public places ~~within the city limits.~~
- (3) Present ~~Presentation of~~ an art budget to the city commission for review.
- (4) Advise the city commission on artists to create artwork for public places.
- (5) Advise the city commission on the maintenance, preservation, and protection of existing artwork in public places.
- (6) Advise the city commission on the removal or replacement of artwork in public places.
- (7) Evaluate and recommend efforts for increasing public awareness and support of art in public places.
- (8) Perform other duties related to acquiring, commissioning, installing, placing, maintaining, preserving, protecting, decommissioning, removing, replacement of art in public places and raising public awareness of art as the city commission may from time to time direct."

### **SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS**

- 3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this ordinance and any other ordinance, in whole or in part, the provisions of this ordinance will prevail to the extent of the conflict.

### **SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY**

- 4.01 If a court of competent jurisdiction finds that any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or provision of this ordinance is for any reason invalid or unconstitutional, that provision will be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance.

### **SECTION 5 – CODIFICATION**

- 5.01 In this ordinance, additions are shown as underlined and deletions as ~~strikethrough~~. Any additional codification information and notations appear in *italics*. These editorial notations are not intended to appear in the codified text.


### **SECTION 6 – EFFECTIVE DATE**

- 6.01 This ordinance takes effect immediately upon adoption.


