Functions as part of the existing Tribute Program.

Contributions will be acknowledged with a plaque on a donor recognition wall installed at the North Port Aquatic Center. Plaque sizes will be determined by the size of the Tribute Donation.

Donors may customize the message to be displayed on the plaque purchased (within vendor specifications and subject to City approval).

Donated plaques may be tax-deductible in support of the City of North Port.

At the end of the donation period, the donated feature will be available for renewal with the first right of refusal given to the original donor.

Total project cost is estimated to be \$14,000 which includes \$9,333 in one-time costs.

DONOR LEVELS

Starfish (\$150) 4''W x 3.5''H

- Plaque remains on donor recognition wall for 1 year(s).

Fish (\$300) 8''W x 4.75''H

- Plaque remains on donor recognition wall for 3 year(s).

Sea Turtle (\$500) 12''W x 7.8''H

- Plaque remains on donor recognition wall for 5 year(s).

Manta Ray (\$1,000) 16''W x 16''H

- Plaque remains on donor recognition wall for 10 year(s).




