ORDINANCE NO. 2022-04

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, ADOPTING A REDISTRICTING PLAN FOR THE CITY'S FIVE CITY COMMISSION DISTRICTS IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 2.02 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT; AMENDING SECTIONS 2-2 AND 2-3 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA TO PROVIDE FOR THE APPROVED REDISTRICTING MAP AND LEGAL DESCRIPTIONS; PROVIDING FOR FINDINGS; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR CODIFICATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2012, City of North Port electors approved dividing the City into five City Commission districts; and

WHEREAS, following the regulations in effect at the time, on December 15, 2014, the City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 2014-41, approving a districting plan and districting map for the City; and

WHEREAS, on December 14, 2015, the City Commission adopted Ordinance No. 2015-51, incorporating the districting map and legal descriptions of each of the five City Commission districts into Chapter 2, Article I of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida ("City Code"); and

WHEREAS, on November 6, 2018, the City's electors approved amendments to the City Charter; and

WHEREAS, included within the amended City Charter is Section 2.02, entitled "Districting and Redistricting Plans"; and

WHEREAS, City Charter Section 2.02 requires the City Commission to approve a redistricting plan by ordinance no later than 10 months (300 days) following each decennial census published results if the results show a substantial change in population from the existing districting plan; and

WHEREAS, City Charter Section 2.02(b)(2) and (3) requires each district to be based on the principle of equal effective representation and to be as equal in population as possible, with no more than a five percent (5%) deviation in population among the districts; and

WHEREAS, on August 12, 2021, the United States Census Bureau published the 2020 Census data which indicated the City's current district population distribution is over the maximum deviation allowed by the City Charter; and

36 37 38	WHEREAS, City Charter Section 2.20(d)1 requires proposed redistricting plans to be made available for public inspection and comment not less than one month before the first public hearing on the plans and that each plan include both a map and description of the recommended district boundaries; and
39	that each plan include both a map and description of the recommended distinct soundaines, and
40 41	WHEREAS , on November 29, 2021, the City posted maps for redistricting plans A and B to the City's website for public inspection and comment, and made printed copies available in the City Clerk's Office;

44 45	WHEREAS , on December 22, 2021, the City posted a map for redistricting plan C to the City's website for public inspection and comment, and made printed copies available in the City Clerk's Office; and

WHEREAS, on January 25, 2022, the City posted legal descriptions for redistricting Plans A, B, and C to the City's website for public inspection and comment, and made printed copies available in the City Clerk's Office; and

WHEREAS, on March 8, 2022, the City Commission held a public hearing and received public comment on the proposed redistricting plans; and

WHEREAS, City Code Sections 2-2 and 2-3 identify the official map and legal descriptions for the City Commission districts; and

WHEREAS, City Charter Section 2.02(d)4 provides that any redistricting plan will take effect for any election held at least one year following final plan approval; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds that the approving a redistricting plan in accordance with the City Charter serves the public welfare of the citizens of the City of North Port, Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:
