### RESOLUTION NO. 2020-R-29

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA, PROVIDING ITS DETERMINATION TO FOREGO THE ANNUAL INCREASE IN CITY COMMISSIONER SALARY FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020-2021; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS**, each City Commissioner receives an annual salary calculated pursuant to Section 2-23 of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2-23(4)c further provides that each City Commissioner's salary shall be recalculated annually pursuant to the codified formula, to take effect each October 1; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 2-23(4)c allows the City Commission, by supermajority vote, to forego an annual salary increase; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Commission has by a vote of at least four (4) Commissioners deemed the adoption of this ordinance as being in the best interest of the citizens of the City of North Port;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF NORTH PORT, FLORIDA:**

#### **SECTION 1 – INCORPORATION OF RECITALS**

1.01 The above recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are incorporated herein by reference.

#### **SECTION 2 – RESOLUTION**

2.01 In accordance with Section 2-23(4)c of the Code of the City of North Port, Florida, the City Commission hereby declares by supermajority vote its decision to forego the annual increase to the City Commissioner salaries for Fiscal Year 2020-2021.

#### **SECTION 3 – CONFLICTS**

3.01 In the event of any conflict between the provisions of this resolution and any other resolution or provisions thereof, the provisions of this resolution shall prevail to the extent of such conflict.

**SECTION 4 – SEVERABILITY**

4.01 If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phase, or provision of this resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such provision shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

**SECTION 5 – EFFECTIVE DATE**

5.01 This resolution shall take effect immediately after adoption by the City Commission of the City of North Port, Florida.
